2012: John VanOrman – in honor of his continued efforts to maintain the historic significance of downtown Idaho falls.

2013: Frank and Belinda VanderSloot and the VanderSloot Foundation – in honor of their continued efforts to maintain the historic significance of the New Sweden School.

2016: Mary Jane Groberg Fritzen – in honor of her continued efforts to maintain the historic significance of Bonneville County as an author, and as a volunteer.
